Ask Me About My Cross

As First Light board members and active volunteers, **Betty Drennen** and **Nancy Skinner** have found their own way of helping to raise money for the shelter and advocate for the homeless women and children in our community. Betty and Nancy have set a new fashion trend by simply wearing crosses handmade by guests in Creative Adventures, First Light's art therapy program,

The cross craze started when Betty Drennen purchased four crosses at the annual First Light Gala. "I bought a cross at the Gala and wore it to my Bible class at IPC...That's all it took! I started selling them off my neck. Thousands of dollars later we are still going strong," said Betty.

"When Betty and I realized how many people were learning about First Light by wearing and selling the crosses, we became even more positive about what

could be done by opening a conversation about homeless women and children in our community. *The crosses we wear are constant reminders of our faith and our dedication to First Light*," said Nancy Skinner.

Marilyn Gross, First Light's volunteer art therapy program coordinator said, "Much to our amazement, First Light has raised more than \$7,000 this year for the shelter from the sale of \$5, \$10 and \$15 crosses! Of course, the purpose of the art therapy program has nothing to do with money or income from sales. It is about healing and restoring lives. I have witnessed God's hand at work in this simple project. The women who come to First Light arrive with lives that are fragmented, broken and in need of mending, just like the old jewelry and broken beads that are donated to our art program. Jewelry that was once in pieces, soon to be discarded, is reworked and transformed into something new-- the cross of Christ, a symbol of struggle, mercy, forgiveness, love and hope. And with God's help, the women who come through the doors of First Light are given a second chance. People are being refashioned, and through the grace of God, lives are being mended, and women are given a new opportunity to start over, to begin again."



ABOUT THE COYER


In Creative Adventures, First Light's weekly art therapy class, shelter guests were asked to describe the Garden of Eden, depicted in Genesis as a place of beauty where all needs were taken care of by God. The Garden was described as a lush, green, beautiful place where humans lived with animals and nature in peace. There was no conflict, pain, jealousy, hunger, homelessness or war.

Guests were asked to imagine such a place, think about living there today and not being homeless any longer. The question was then asked: "What would your own Garden of Eden look like?"


Using available materials, each woman created a picture describing Eden, their place of joy, rest and peace. When asked to imagine what her Garden of Eden would look like, one guests replied, "I already know that place. Sometimes when life gets really bad, I have to go there in my mind." Her Eden paints the cover of this annual report.

Emergency Shelter

First Light provided 14,581 nights of shelter for an unduplicated 895 guests: 784 homeless women and 111 children.

419 mental health assessments were completed and documented for emergency shelter guests.

Of the 895 women and children served at First Light during the fiscal year, only 58 returned during the year.

85% suffer from mental illness

90% have been abused at some point in their lives

7% are veterans

59% are active or recovering addicts 17% have a physical disability

Permanent Supportive Housing

First Light provided 9 units of permanent supportive housing for 13 women with serious mental illnesses.

100% of residents met with a psychiatrist at least once every 6 months.

92% of residents complied with psychiatrists' treatment recommendations.

100% of residents participated in at least 2 life skills programs per month.

70% of residents participated in at least 4 hours of outside activity (i.e. volunteer work, exercise or programs) per month.

Transportation Program

Transportation assistance is provided to emergency shelter guests who do not have an income. This program is vital for helping First Light guests get out of homelessness. In addition to providing bus tokens, First Light also pays for taxi cab service in necessary situations. Providing cab service to the emergency room when an ambulance is not crucial saves guests an ambulance bill they most likely cannot afford to pay. The following is a summation of transportation destinations and the number of trips.



Led by Marilyn Gross, First Light's volunteer art therapy coordinator, the guests of First Light's emergency shelter and residents of the permanent supportive housing program participate in a weekly art therapy program called Creative Adventures! Affirmation and Healing through Art. "Creating art is an opportunity for the guests and residents of First Light to do something different, to forget for one moment about all of the pain in their lives that led them to homelessness and to gain a sense of accomplishment," said Art Therapy Coordinator, Marilyn Gross. "Whenever there is illness, brokenness, and pain, there is a diminishment of soul. Making art can be a pathway of healing and a source of comfort, enhancing life and well-being. Art can also be an opportunity to rebuild social skills—a way to reconnect to the world."
